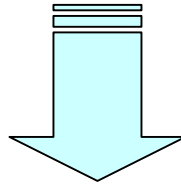

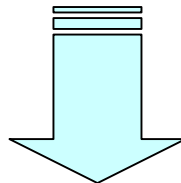
SfC National

Leadership & Management

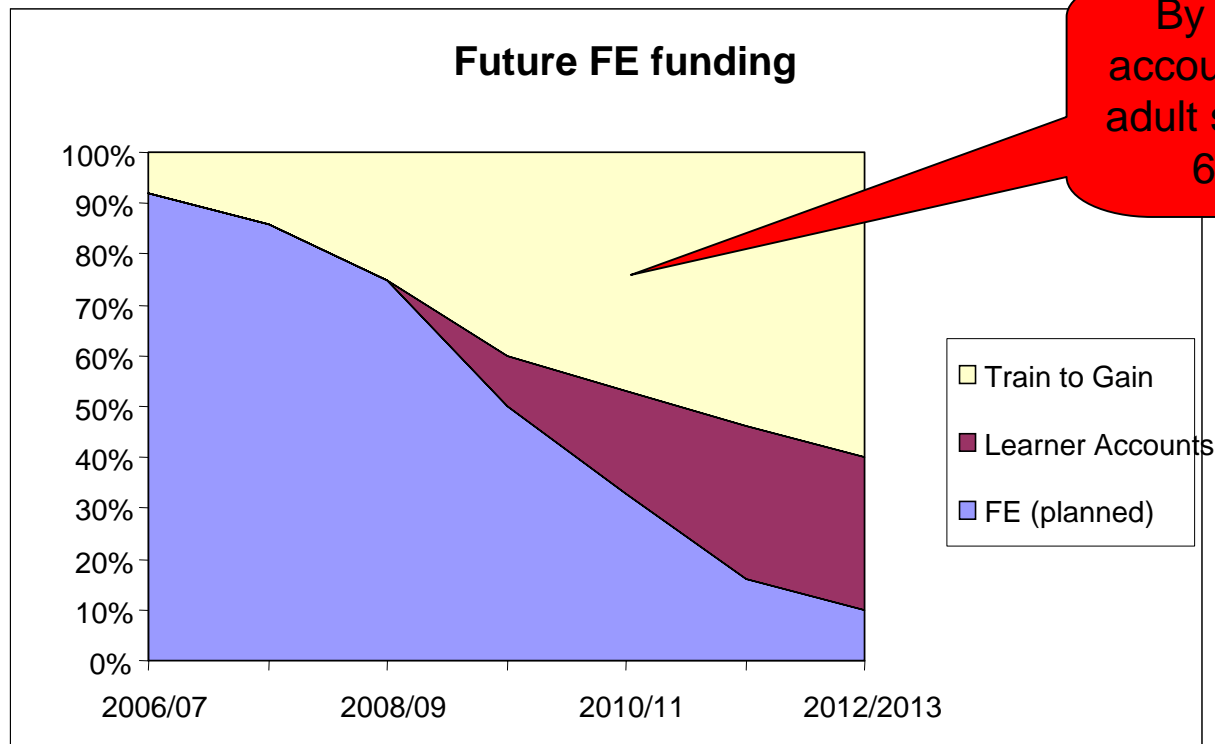
- **Successful Supervisory Management**
Programme developed – series of workshops
 - First line managers in social care setting
 - 3 cohorts of 15 from NE (up to March 07)
 - 10 days of attendance
 - ILM accredited
- **Business Leadership Conference – 27 Nov**
- **L&M working group**

Care Assessor Network

- **150** qualified and peripatetic assessors (**30 per sub region** – by March 2008)
 - Includes CYP assessors and Internal Verifiers
- Training available for assessors to train to become IV and for new assessors
- CPD for assessors signed up to the network as well as a quarterly newsletter
