Communities of Practice (CoP) brings people together and enables individuals to form online communities that encourage knowledge sharing and learning.

WHAT ARE THE FEATURES - some of the features include

forums - ask questions and post info

wikis - post a document for others', input or amend existing documents

events - promote events/meetings

library - upload, share and track documents

blog - an online journal or diary that others can comment on

search facility - search for documents, wikis, blogs, people and events

alerts - daily summaries from your communities direct to your e-mail inbox.
